JL Tree Service will be removing a hazardous tree on Fairfax County courthouse property that extends over the roadway.

Southbound Chain Bridge Rd will be closed to traffic at Main St and traffic will detour to either westbound North St or westbound Main St, turn left to Judicial Dr, and follow Judicial Dr back to Chain Bridge Rd.

Northbound Chain Bridge Rd traffic will be stopped periodically for up to 10min at a time to safely lower cut tree limbs to the ground.

Please see the map on the next page for the workzone location and detour route. University Dr is an alternate north-south route through downtown Fairfax that will avoid this workzone.

Please be advised that this work may require Miss Utility to mark underground utilities in and around the work area, as required by the Virginia Underground Utility Damage Prevention Act. Utility location marks will be made with either temporary paint or flags on public roadways and sidewalks, private driveways, as well as in grass areas both on public and private property. Markings are for location identification only and do not indicate locations of excavation. Miss Utility often marks beyond the limits of the work area for safety and reference purposes. Miss Utility markings may be repeatedly refreshed until work is completed in that particular area. The City has no control over Miss Utility marking requests.
